

Embroidery **C**lub **R**equirements

Pocket Lanyard

Create your own stylised pocket lanyard. Perfect to take to the Quilt Shows to store your passes, business cards, notebook, pen and mobile phone.



Cutting Requirements:

- Pocket 1 – 10" x 6" (Small pocket)
- Pocket 2 – 12" x 6" (Medium pocket)
- Pocket 3 – 14" x 6" (Large pocket)
- Background Fabric – 8 ½" x 6"
- Clear Plastic – 3 ½" x 6"
- Backing Fabric – 12" x 6" & 6" x 6"

Stabiliser Requirements:

- 50cm Tearaway
- 1m Perfect Stick or Filmoplast
- 50cm Fusible Cutaway
- 25cm Solvy (think plastic)

General Requirements:

- Embroidery Machine & Unit
- 180 x 130 hoop minimum
- 75 & 90 Embroidery Needles
- Tweezer Snips
- Thread Stand (optional)
- Sharp Scissors – Must be able to cut through several layers of fabric. I recommend the Canary brand.
- Teflon sheet

Other Requirements:

- 1m Cotton Webbing (1" wide)
- 1m Decorative Ribbon (1" wide)
- Assorted Embroidery Threads
- Bobbin Fill
- 606 Fusible Applique Spray
- Mini Steam Iron
- Rotary Cutter, Mat, Ruler
- Point Turner

All of the above class requirements are available with a 10% discount if purchased in store!

This project is recommended for 100% cotton fabrics.
